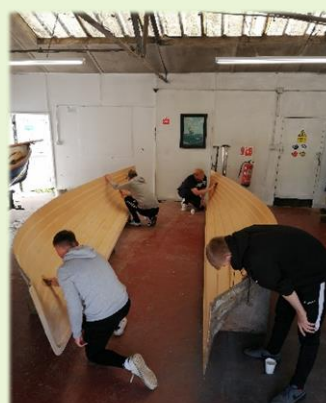

Course Structure:

Each course is a nominal 40 hours however each course structure will be customised to suit the needs of specific groups and individuals. The delivery of the course can be either; evenings, weekends, residential or a combination of all 3.
